The Board of Directors of Empire Electric Association, Inc. has a scholarship program for the purpose of aiding dependents of deserving members in the area served by the Association to obtain a post high school education. The applicant or the applicant's parents or legal guardian must be a member of Empire Electric in order for the student to qualify for a scholarship.

This scholarship shall be used for bonafide educational expenses as determined by the institution attended and must be used within the next school year following the grant of the scholarship or it will be forfeited by the recipient unless a delay is approved by the Board of Directors.

Consideration will be given to scholastic standing, character, desire to obtain a college education and economic needs determined without regard to race, creed, color, sex or religious beliefs. Please make sure that all items are furnished on the list below in order for the scholarship committee to make an informed decision about the applicant.

- A. Your most recent academic transcript from school
- B. Copy of your college entrance examination (ACT and/or SAT) scores
- C. Two letters of reference from a teacher, counselor, or employer
- D. Document high school activities, school and community honors and activities
- E. Written essay outlining your career goals, family situation, including financial need, and why you are applying for this scholarship.

You may only apply for one scholarship – either the \$1000 2 to 4 year accredited college scholarship or the \$500 vocational scholarship. To be considered by the Board of Directors, this completed application must be returned to the Executive Secretary at Empire Electric no later than **February 15** of the current year.

The scholarship committee will not consider this application if information is missing or incomplete.

Social Security No. will be requested for identification purposes at the college should you be a successful applicant

NOTE: Basin Electric Power gives a \$1000 scholarship to one student in Empire's territory. By filling out this application, you are automatically considered for the Basin Scholarship.
