Outages

If you experience an outage, please report it to us at 970-565-4444 or 800-709-3726. This helps us to pinpoint the extent and exact location of the outage.

Call 811 before you dig.

When digging underground for any reason, call for utility line locates. You will need to know to know the physical address of the property and the exact location of the dig which should be marked. You may also be asked the names of the two closest intersections to the property.

You have a voice through the member services department, at monthly board meetings, and the annual meeting where you can vote on cooperative by-laws and the board of directors.

Capital Credits



When you pay your energy bill each month, you are accumulating equity in your cooperative through the capital credits allocation. If there is any revenue after all the operating

expenses are paid each year, members are allocated their portion of that margin.

Each year, the Board of Directors considers the financial state of the cooperative and determines what and how many capital credits will be returned to its members. The cooperative exists to provide a service to its memberowners, not to make a profit.

Energy Efficiency Rebates



Empire Electric members are eligible for rebates on qualifying energy efficiency products.

Residential rebates for newly purchased Energy Star® qualified appliances include: refrigerators,

freezers, clothes washers and dryers, split system air-conditioners, LEDs, and dishwashers. Qualifying electric water heaters and heat pumps are also on the list of rebates.

Lighting retrofits, new construction lighting rebates, heat pumps and electric motor rebates are available for Commercial and Industrial members.
