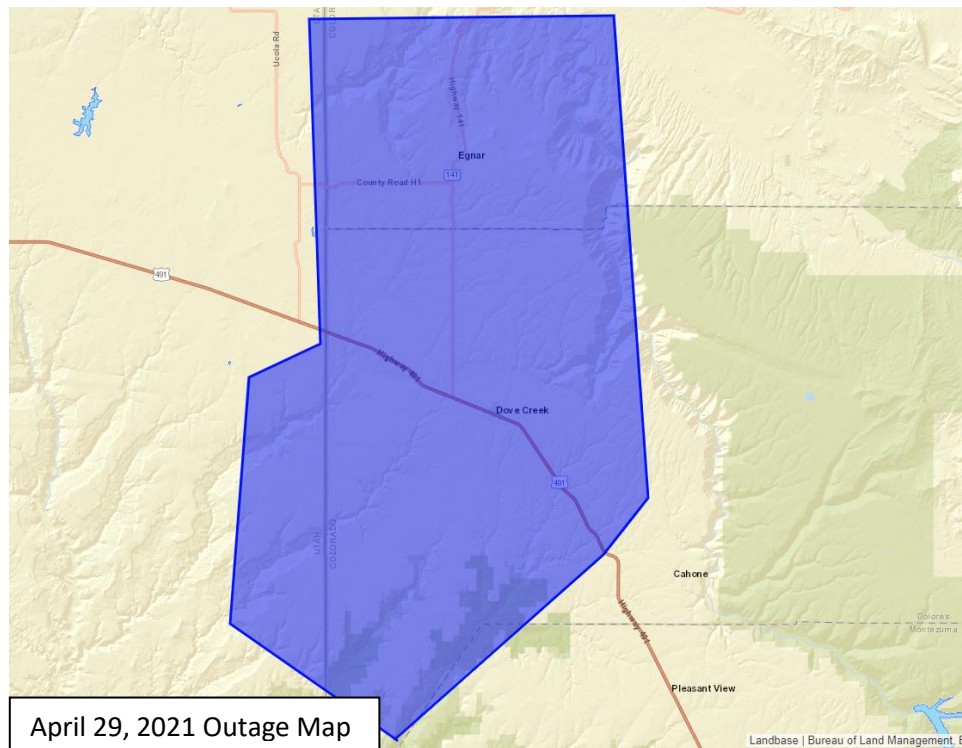
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EEA Schedules Dove Creek Maintenance Outage for April 29, 2021

Substation Maintenance Critical to Maintaining Reliability

EEA has scheduled a planned outage at the Dove Creek substation starting at 11:30 PM Thursday April 29, 2021 and lasting until approximately 2:00 AM on Friday April 30. The outage is necessary to allow EEA crews to perform required repairs and maintenance. The repairs will be made near high voltage conductors so the substation must be de-energized to allow the work to be done in a safe manner.

Phone calls will be made to all impacted services on Thursday April 29. Outage preparation and safety information can be found at eea.coop/prepare-outage. Please remember to turn off any electrical equipment and appliances you do not need, especially sensitive electronics. A map of the general outage area is shown below:
